

## Selected Paper and Symposium Submission Instructions

2007 NAREA Annual Meetings, June 10-13 in Rehoboth Beach, Delaware  
Deadline for Submission: February 15, 2007

Please read these instructions thoroughly before submitting a proposal. This year NAREA will be using an on-line submission format with a firm submission deadline.

For Selected Papers please submit an extended abstract of no more than 500 words. The Selected Papers Committee will review abstracts in terms of problem statement, methods, results, and relevance to NAREA membership. Individuals whose abstracts are selected will be notified by email on or about April 1, 2007, and will be asked to write a paper for presentation at the meetings in Rehoboth Beach, Delaware. Final papers are due to the Chair of the Selected Papers Committee no later than June 1, 2007. Individuals who do not submit a completed paper by June 1, 2007, will not have abstracts of their selected papers published in the *Agricultural and Resource Economics Review*. Group submissions around a specific topic also are encouraged.

Proposals for Symposia have no restrictions on format or content, but should emphasize audience discussion. Symposium proposals should include: 1) a description of the topic; 2) reason why the topic is timely and of interest to the membership; 3) suggested format and description of the presentation.

### Online Submission Instructions:

- 1) The submission process proceeds in **two-steps**. You first must fill out the submission form providing contact and proposal information. You will be sent an email confirming your submission once this is complete. The second step includes checking the status and accuracy of your submission. You may do this using the "Proposal Status" link in the left banner of the NAREA 2007 Conference web pages. You must enter in your last name and password. (Please note that if you are the primary author of more than one proposal that you should use a different password for each submission).
- 2) You can track the status of your proposal (whether it has been accepted, rejected or is pending) using the "Proposal Status" link as well. Information about the acceptance and rejection will be posted to the conference web page. Emails will be sent to inform of updates on when these postings are made.
- 3) The following information is required for submission:
  - a) Lead presenter and co-author names
  - b) Address and affiliation
  - c) Email address
  - d) Password (to be used to check the status of your proposal). ***If you are the primary author of more than one proposal, please use a different password for each submission.***
  - e) Title of presentation (maximum 90 characters – approximately 15 words)
  - f) Short abstract for publication in the *Agricultural and Resource Economics Review* (maximum 350 characters – approximately 50 words)
  - g) Extended abstract (maximum of 4000 characters – approximately 500 words)
  - h) Paper's subject area: Consumer, Environment, Marketing, Natural Resources, Trade, Rural/Regional Development, Production/Management, Other – Specify
