

2010 NAREA Conference Workshop Call for Proposals

The NAREA Board of Directors is seeking proposals for the workshop to accompany the 2010 annual meeting to be hosted by Rutgers University. Proposals should appeal broadly to our membership, incorporating ideas from both agricultural and natural resource economics. Thus, proposals that integrate a broad number of subject areas (e.g., environment, trade, production, or marketing) are preferred by the Board of Directors. This broad appeal, however, must be balanced with a coherent and clear theme. The Board anticipates that the authors of the selected proposal will provide leadership in implementing the workshop, in cooperation with the Board of Directors and Rutgers University.

The annual NAREA conference has included an accompanying workshop since 2002. Previous workshop topics have focused on such issues as land use policy, invasive species, and trade and the environment. The selected 2009 workshop topic is the incorporation of experimental economic methods into applied research and teaching. The NAREA Board expects all workshop papers to be submitted for publication consideration to *The Agricultural and Resource Economics Review*. These papers, which will be subject to an expedited peer review, will be considered for publication in the April 2011 issue of the journal.

Proposals should include the following:

- Proposal author(s), affiliation, and contact information
- Workshop Title
- Workshop Justification (please address the following)
 - Timeliness of proposed topic
 - Ability to appeal to broad audience of NAREA members
- Anticipated presenters, if targeted invitations are included in the proposal
 - Name, title, affiliation, role in workshop
- Preliminary Budget
 - Anticipated revenue sources (including grants, gifts, registration fee)
 - Anticipated costs (including speaker fees, travel, materials, and journal page charges)
